Whereas, in the Police Officers Prayer, it says, *I ask for dedication. Dedication to my job, to do it well. Dedication to my community, to keep it safe;* and


Whereas, the men and women of law enforcement deserve to know they have the support, the respect, and the trust of their community.

Whereas, we respectfully request that every citizen respects and supports the Village of Sugar Grove Police Officers and Police Officers that serve the communities throughout our great nation.




