It was then demolished in 1999.
- 1990 School Property on Main Street was purchased and was used as Village Hall and the Police Station until the Municipal Building was opened in 1992 at its location on Municipal Drive
- 1991 Annexation of Roppollo Property. Inland later purchased the property and in 2002 it was developed as Lakes of Bliss Woods
- 1991 Annexing the GrommesHarkinson/Harte properties. Was then developed and became Black Walnut Trails
- 1992 Lang's Subdivision (Denny Road) Annexed
- 1992 Village Offices at 10 Municipal (then Kingsland Drive) open
- 1992 Hinckley State Bank opens on Dugan and Route 30. Later sold to Oak Trust Credit Union

- 1996 Sale of Elementary School back to District 302. The Village donated he proceeds to the Park District and entered into an agreement for use of Park District owned property in as a part of the donation. Kaneland South opened in 1998 and was later renamed John Shields.
- 1997 Bliss/47 signalization Prior to the installation of this signal the only "stop light" in SG was at Cross and Rt. 47. Dugan Road was signalized in 2001. Heartland and Waubonsee Drive signalized in 2007
- 1997 First In Car Police video camera installed. Thanks to George Adams and the Jaycees for this valuable piece of equipment.

- 1998 Main / Snow Street Reconstruction. North Main Street was full of pot holes from Cross to Meadows and not fully curbed, Snow Street had curbs however no storm sewers. This was a major undertaking for which the Village had set aside MFT funds to undertake for many years. Storm Sewers and curbs were installed and Main St. became a functioning roadway.
- 1999 Annexation to Fox Metro Water Reclamation District. Prior to this SG operated a sewer plant that was on Golfview near the golf course - in a flood plain, constantly flooded.
- 1999 Annexing Territory to the VOSG - McVay Farm Property (Wiseman-Hughes Development)
- 1999 Fox Metro Connection occurred in December and demolition of Sugar Grove Sewer Treatment Plant begins. At this time the Public Works staff occupies a trailer located on the Village Water Property on Railroad Street.
- 1999 SSA 1 and SSA 2 Amendments These bonds were originally approved in 1990 - due to the manner in which they were incorrectly allocated no development occurred.

- 2000 Boundary Agreements first adopted Montgomery, Yorkville, Aurora, Batavia, North Aurora, Plano - negotiating began in 2000 Yorkville first adopted in 2000
- 2000 Main Street renovations. Main Street will be completely renovated from the Railroad Tracks
- 2001 1st Open House held at Sugar Grove Community House
- 2001 1st Year awarded CAFR
- 2001 Annexation of Windsor Pointe
- 2001 Building of Wheeler Road Park - Sugar Grove Sports Complex. This facility includes four baseball/softball fields, two soccer fields, and a concession stand. This property was leased to the Village by the City of Aurora and the project accomplished by a IDNG Grant.

- 2001 Public Works Facility at 601 Heartland Opens
- 2001 Sugar Grove Police Officer Brooks Boyce has been nominated for the Kane County Police Officer of the Year Award. Officer Boyce was nominated for Officer of the Year based on his response to a car accident in March of 2000 involving two vehicles on U.S. Route 30.
- 2001 The Illinois Department of Transportation completed improvements to Route 30, which included the installation of a traffic light at the intersection of Dugan Road and the ability to enter and exit Route 30 at Municipal Drive. The timing of the traffic light is being addressed, but any user of Dugan Road will tell you, the light has improved traffic flow and has increased the safety of motorists in that area. Other road improvements that the Village made in 2002 included parts of Prairie Street, Wheeler Road, and Richards Street. The Village Board has been diligently completing road improvements over the past few years. Improvements to the roadway system continue to be one of the board's highest priorities.

- 2001 The public works facility was completed on time and under budget. The Village was able to take advantage of a slow commercial construction environment and low interest rates to construct a state-of-the-art facility. The Public Works staff moved into their new home during June, and a town meeting was held in September to introduce the new facility. This facility allows for inside storage of all the equipment used by the Village to maintain the streets, water and sewer systems, parks, and streetlights.

Because of the tremendous increase in population the Village will be conducting a special census through the Census Bureau. Sugar Grove is honored to be the second community in the nation to be approved to have a Special Census conducted. This allows the Village to receive additional funding from the state based on our population.
