## Village Responds to COVID-19 Pandemic

The global COVID-19 pandemic that made its impact in our area in early March has demanded our collective strength, determination and patience. The past few months have presented extraordinary challenges and from the beginning, the Village of Sugar Grove took steps to protect the safety and security of our residents and employees and support our local businesses.

In mid-March the Village limited public access to Village facilities as staff continued to provide services to residents and customers through email, online and over the phone. The Village has assisted local business owners with the issuance of temporary liquor licenses for the sale of alcohol for carry out and/or delivery and through local business wellness checks. For our utility customers, the Village has offered flexible payment plans for those struggling to pay their bills. To facilitate a coordinated community response, the Village has conducted weekly conference calls with representatives from local taxing districts and since April, the Village has held remote Village Board meeting via GoToMeeting allowing for public participation via phone and email.

The Village knows that this pandemic is not yet over. As the nation and state look to re-open in the coming months, the Village will continue to take appropriate steps to protect and support our residents and community.

## 2020 Village Road Program

The 2020 Village of Sugar Grove Road Program will focus on Resurfacing and Preventative Maintenance. This year's program will include:

1. Microsurfacing and ADA Accessibility Improvements throughout Windsor West subdivision. Microsurfacing is a pavement preservation treatment in which a slurry is applied to the road to seal the road and provide a dense wearing surface.
2. Resurfacing of the remaining areas of Strafford Woods, McCannon Street (Maple to Bastian), Yolane Drive (McCannon Street to Patricia) and Mallard Point Subdivision (except Cobbler Court and Lane). Resurfacing projects involve street resurfacing, curb and gutter repairs, and minor storm sewer repairs. This work is necessary to improve safety and help eliminate the pavement deterioration adjacent to these areas.
3. Cracksealing on various streets including Calkins Drive, Cobbler Lane, Cobbler Court, Dugan Road, Fays Lane/Annettes Circle, Gordon Road, Grove Street, Heartland Drive, Monna Drive, Snow Street and Waubensee Drive.
4. Miscellaneous patching on Merrill Road.
5. Sealcoating and striping of the Village Hall and the front parking lot at Public Works.




Work on the 2020 Road Program projects began in May and is anticipated to be completed by August of 2020. Daily lane closures and temporary loss of driveway access will be necessary to complete the work. The times and dates for loss of driveway access will be communicated to affected residents by door hangers distributed by the Contractor performing the work as the schedule progresses.

The Village appreciates your understanding and cooperation during these construction projects. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

- Even-numbered street addresses may water on even-numbered calendar dates between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- Odd-numbered street addresses may water on odd-numbered calendar dates between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
