## Reporting a Water Main Break

Water main breaks happen year round, but they are more common during the winter months. Depending on the size of the main and the severity, a main break may look like water actively bubbling up from the ground or it may be as simple as a small stream of water flowing into a storm sewer.

Residents play a crucial role in reporting breaks. If you see bubbling or running water accumulating in the street or the parkway, please contact the Public Works Department during its regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) at 630-391-7230 to report an active break. Outside of those hours, contact the Police Department at 9-1-1.

When you call to report a water main break, be sure to identify:

- the type of problem
- the location
- your name, address and phone number as officials may need to get in touch with you, should they need more information.



The Village of Sugar Grove appreciates calls at any time to report a water main break as these calls may be the first alert that a problem exists.

## Want to Receive Future Village Surveys?

The Village of Sugar Grove recently issued a survey using emails on file for residential utility bill accounts. In the future, the Village may choose to use this method of gathering feedback again. If you did not receive a survey, the Village does not have your email address on file. If you would like to add an email address to your utility bill account, please submit your street address and a valid email account to [genlog@sugargroveil.gov](mailto:genlog@sugargroveil.gov). Two email addresses per account will be accepted.

Please note, if you have more than one email address attached to a household utility account and you have elected to receive your utility bills electronically, bills will be sent to all emails on that account.

Also note that submitting an email address does not automatically enroll you for paperless billing.

## Winter Parking Restrictions

Per Village Code Section 6-3-7 (Winter Parking), it is unlawful to park any vehicle on any public street within the Village at any time during or after a snowfall wherein two (2) or more inches of snow have fallen until such street has been plowed.

DC Recycling Systems will collect Christmas trees on your normal pickup day January 6 thru January 28.

Trees must be free of decorations, including tinsel. Flocked trees will not be accepted. Trees cannot be in a plastic bag. Trees longer than 6 feet must be cut into smaller pieces.
