ISSUE

Discussion of the installation of “No Parking This Side of Street” signs in Settlers Ridge.

DISCUSSION

As part of the Final Engineering plans for the Settlers Ridge subdivision, “No Parking This Side of Street” signs were to be installed on the fire hydrant side of all streets except Settlers Boulevard and Parkside Drive. As part of the subdivision completion efforts the Village has undertaken with the proceeds from the bond settlement, staff plans to install the missing signs.

As a courtesy, Village staff notified the Homeowners Association (HOA) of the pending installation. The HOA is opposed to the installation because the Village already restricts overnight parking and they view the additional restrictions as unnecessary. The HOA has requested a variance from the Engineering plans and Village policy.

Other subdivisions such as Windsor Point, Walnut Woods and Meadowridge Villas are already signed similarly to the required posting in Settlers Ridge.

Chief Rollins and Assistant Chief Parsons, who will be on hand to participate in the discussion for the sign requirements, have both stated that the No Parking This Side of Street regulations are important for Public Safety response.

COST

The estimated cost of installing the signs would be approximately \$5,500. The costs would be charged to the Bond Settlement.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Village Board discuss and direct Staff on how to proceed with the signage installation in Settlers Ridge.
