ISSUE

Should the Village surplus equipment that is no longer being utilized.

DISCUSSION

State Statute requires that all property owned by the Village that is to be replaced, has outlived its useful life or is no longer necessary to conduct Village business be declared surplus prior to disposal.

At this time staff is requesting the authority to surplus Squad as referenced in the attached ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 20190108
AN ORDINANCE DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Village of Sugar Grove is not a home rule municipality within Article VII, Section 6A of the Illinois Constitution and, pursuant to the powers granted to it under 65 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*; and,

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village find it is no longer useful to or necessary for the best interests of the Village to continue to possess the below listed item(s) of personal property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

The corporate authorities of the Village of Sugar Grove hereby authorize the surplus of the aforementioned personal property. The aforementioned property may be advertised for sale, sold by public auction or other means without advertising the sale, presented as trade in for replacement equipment or property, or may be donated to a not for profit agency. In the event that any such items are not sold, traded, or donated, they may be scrapped.

SECTION TWO: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
