ISSUE

2019 Proposed Tax Levy Public Hearing.

DISCUSSION

The proposed tax levy was announced at the November 5, 2019, Regular Board Meeting. State Law requires that a taxing body hold a public hearing prior to passage of the tax levy ordinance if the operating portion of the proposed tax levy increases more than 5% when compared to the prior year's extended operating levy. The Village's proposed levy meets this criterion. Notice of the public hearing was published pursuant to State Law in the November 7, 2018, edition of the Kane County Chronicle. It is anticipated that passage of the tax levy ordinance will take place at the December 3, 2019, Board Meeting. A copy of the proposed ordinance is also included with your packet. The actual anticipated levy is \$1,757,379, which is \$42,205 or 2.46% above last year's levy extension.

ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois:
