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**ISSUE**

Should the Village Board approve the purchase of one 2020 Police Ford Utility SUV for patrol.

**DISCUSSION**

In accordance with the rotation of our police vehicles, the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget included funds to purchase replacement of two Police Vehicles. The first vehicle has already come before the Village Board and was approved; this request is for the second vehicle that is budgeted.

The second vehicle in the budget to be replaced is a 2014 Ford Sedan Police Interceptor that was placed into service back in October 2013. The squad is approaching 7 years in service, currently at 119,430 driven miles and has tens of thousands of engine hours run time.

COVID-19 has caused havoc with new car productions, as the vehicle manufacturing plants closed down for a couple of months to produce other items, such as respirators. Ford production of the Police Interceptor plant went back on-line in June. They are currently fulfilling 2020 model year orders placed from February to April at this time. The plant production line is due to switch over in September for the 2021 model and will be temporary closed for the changeover. If an order was to be placed for the 2021 model, we were informed the car would not be built close to 26 weeks out, placing it into February or March 2021 delivery period, if the plants do not close again.

Currie Ford who holds the contract through the Northwest Municipal Conference Suburban Cooperative had placed a number of extra police vehicle orders on top of other orders placed by police departments back in April (which was the contract price close out/deadline to place orders). Included in their extra orders is a white 2020 Ford

Utility SUV. This vehicle matches our current police fleet with similar options. This vehicle is coming off the production line shortly and would be sold off Currie's lot for any police agency interested at the contract price (no upcharge). This vehicle is a Hybrid and is anticipated to save fuel costs over the life of the vehicle due to the number of hours the squads run and sit idle.

Staff recommends that we purchase the 2020 Ford Utility SUV model that will be available through Currie Ford, the awarded bidder contract holder for the Northwest Municipal Conference Suburban Purchasing Cooperative vs. waiting on the 2021 model and pushing out a delivery to early spring of 2021 or potentially longer if the plants close again. Once the vehicle is delivered to us, it will still take another month or two to be outfitted with all the equipment and then be placed into service.

### **COST**

The cost for the 2020 Ford Utility SUV is \$41,136.00. An additional \$21,648 is budgeted to provide emergency lighting, cage, storage compartments, laptop, radar, radios, squad video package, installation, and other miscellaneous equipment. The Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Capital Projects Fund, account 30-51-7006: Automotive Equipment includes \$62,784 for the replacement Police Vehicle.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

That the Village Board approves the purchase of the 2020 Police Ford Utility SUV and associated costs to outfit it and that the Village Board waives the bidding process and approves a resolution authorizing the purchase of one 2020 Ford SUV utilizing the Northwest Municipal Suburban Purchasing Cooperative.
